Later this summer The Urology Group will open a \$20 million advanced-care surgery facility in Norwood, Ohio. The center will offer integrated care and services under one roof, including treatment for prostate cancer, clinical research and a pathology lab. All 34 of the group's physicians will have access to the facility to provide advanced care for their patients.

The Urology Group is increasing awareness of urologic conditions and their treatments, including that of prostate cancer. The American Cancer Society's most recent statistics on prostate cancer in the United States estimate about 240,890 new cases a year, with about 33,720 of those resulting in deaths. Prostate cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in men, behind lung cancer.
