Dr. Gary Kirsh Elected National President of Medical Association

Kirsh earned his medical degree from the University of Chicago's Pritzker School of Medicine and completed his urology residency at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio. He has been certified by the American Board of Urology and is licensed in the state of Ohio.
