Among other health issues, the impact of prostate cancer is significant. It is the second most common cancer killer of men, behind only lung cancer. About one man in seven will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his lifetime.

Movember will culminate on Monday, November 28 at 6 p.m. with a public shaving of the physicians at the Indian Mound Café.
