CYBERKNIFE REACHES 5-YEAR MILESTONE 1,600 PRECISION PROSTATE TREATMENTS AND COUNTING

Beating prostate disease every day is our mission, and we're on track: Since introducing the highly precise CyberKnife® stereotactic body radiation therapy system in 2013, The Urology Group has performed a procedure nearly every day, dramatically improving prostate cancer management for for nearly 1,600 men.

Radiating the prostate can be tricky because the gland tends to move during treatment. CyberKnife's advanced software system and body-adapting design enables eyelash precision, zeroing in on the affected area while avoiding healthy tissue, minimizing side effects to urinary, bowel and sexual function. This non-invasive procedure also is faster than others—often five treatments in as little as a week.

The Urology Group and GE Aviation hosted more than 70 Korean War Veterans for a patriotic program and luncheon on July 27, 2018, celebrating the 65th anniversary of the armistice that ended the Korean War in 1953. The Korean War veterans, mostly patients of The Urology Group and GE retirees, were honored in speeches from Dr. Doug Lantry, curator at the National Museum of the U.S. Air Force, and Steve Maynard, a former commander of the USS Blue Ridge, flag-ship of the U.S. Seventh Fleet. The event made national news in an article by The Associated Press and received nationwide TV coverage from Fox News. It is believed to have been the nation's largest single gathering of Korean War veterans on the momentous occasion.

11TH ANNUAL PROSTATE RACE ATTRACTS 1,000; RAISES MORE THAN \$115,000

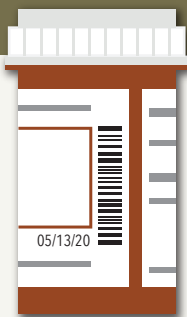
Here's one way to keep prostate cancer prevention on track—by hoofing around the horse track at Belterra Park Cincinnati, where more than 1,000 runners, walkers and supporters gathered September 22 for The Gentlemen Stakes 5K.

Our 11th prostate cancer run helped raise more than \$115,000 to benefit the national nonprofit group ZERO—The End of Prostate Cancer. About one in eight men is diagnosed with prostate cancer each year, yet nearly 100% live at least another five years when the cancer is caught early.

Prostate cancer is highly curable, which is why more than 800 runners and walkers took to the 24-furlong course, pacing through Riverbend Music Center and Coney Island before finishing on Belterra's horse track, where more than 200 volunteers and supporters cheered.
